COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 318, L.D. 1058

FISCAL NOTE

2 The Legislature may require additional General Fund 4 appropriations if the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources must meet during an interim between sessions in order 6 to confer with the Department of Environmental Protection. While the amounts that may be required can not be determined, per diem 8 and expenses of committee members are estimated to be \$1,365 per day.' 10 12 SUMMARY 14 This amendment changes the title and replaces the bill. The amendment requires the Department of Environmental Protection to 16 confer with the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources before it proposes any revisions to the state implementation plan 18 that is required under the federal Clean Air Act that would require the State to implement new emissions reduction strategies 20 or programs or substantially revise or terminate existing emissions reduction strategies or programs. The amendment also 22 adds a fiscal note to the bill.
