36	SUMMARY
38	This bill requires all individual and group contracts of
40	nonprofit hospital and medical services and health care organizations, insurers and health maintenance organizations to
42	provide insurance coverage for prostate cancer screening. Coverage for prostate cancer screening must be provided annually
44	to men 50 years of age or older; to African-American men 45 years of age or older; and to men 40 years of age or older with a
46	family history of prostate cancer.
48	The bill applies to all policies and contracts in effect on or after January 1, 1998.
