

### **An Act Pertaining to the Sanford National Guard Armory.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §264, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:**

6 3-A. Sanford Armory. If the Adjutant General decides to  
8 sell the Sanford Armory, the armory and land deeded to the State  
for armory purposes by the Town of Sanford in 1955 must first be  
offered for sale to the Town of Sanford for \$1.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 In 1955 the Town of Sanford deeded land to the State for use  
16 as an armory. In Public Law 1995, chapter 684, the Adjutant  
18 General of the Maine National Guard was authorized to sell the  
20 Sanford Armory because it was no longer of use to the State.  
This bill requires the State to offer the armory and property for  
sale to the Town of Sanford for \$1.
