14	In 1955 the Town of Sanford deeded land to the State for use
	as an armory. In Public Law 1995, chapter 684, the Adjutant
16	General of the Maine National Guard was authorized to sell the
	Sanford Armory because it was no longer of use to the State.

	sale to the Town of Sanford for \$1.
