Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §714, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Restrictions. The wholesale or retail sale of malt
6 liquor in a keg to a purchaser as authorized by this section may
be made only to an individual who is the agent of a licensee or
8 licensed establishment.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits the sale of malt liquor in kegs to 14 individuals unless those individuals are agents of a licensee or licensed establishment.
