2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15901, sub-§4-A, as amended by PL 1991, c. 268, §6, is further amended to read:
6	4-A. Small scale school construction project. "Small scale school construction project" means a project that will not be
8	eligible for state subsidy and is limited to:
10	A. New buildings not exceeding 600 square feet in gross area to be utilized solely for storage or custodial work, or
12	both; or
14	B. On-site additions to existing school buildings not exceeding 600 square feet in gross area.
16	"Small scale school construction project" does not mean the
18	purchase, lease-purchase or construction of portable temporary classroom space, as defined in section 15603, subsection 19-A or
20	the lease-purchase of bus garage and maintenance facilities, as defined in section 15603, subsection 6-A.

24	Notwithstanding this subsection, a small scale construction project is eligible for funding if it meets the specifications in section 15905-B.
26	Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15905-B is enacted to read:
28	<u>§15905-B. Approval of small scale construction projects with 50%</u>
30	local funding
32	1. Approval authority. The state board may approve a small
34	scale construction project with 50% local funding in accordance with the rules adopted pursuant to this section. The state board may approve up to \$500,000 in debt service in any year for the
36	purpose of funding projects that meet the requirements of this section.

40	2. Eligible projects. A project eligible for funding under this section may not exceed \$150,000 and 50% of the project must be funded by the local school administrative unit.

44	3. Rules. The state board shall adopt or amend rules relating to the approval of small scale construction projects with 50% local funding, including establishing procedures for
46	prioritizing and selecting projects for approval. Rules adopted under this section are major substantive rules pursuant to Title
48	5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

	4. Local vote. Prior to approval by the state board, a
2	small scale construction project with 50% local funding must
	receive a favorable vote in accordance with section 15904.

	Sec. 3. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to June
6	30, 1996.

	SUMMARY

	This bill allows the Board of Education to approve funding
12	for small scale construction projects if 50% of the funding comes
	from the local school administrative unit and the project cost
14	does not exceed \$150,000. The state board is authorized to
	approve up to \$500,000 for eligible projects annually.
