HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 338, L.D. 1116, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §4572, as amended by PL 1995, c. 393, §§12 and 13, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

This section does not apply to an employer with 5 or fewer employees.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Maine Human Rights Commission will realize some minor savings from a reduction in the number of cases regarding unlawful employment discrimination.

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts an employer with 5 or fewer employees from the provisions of the Maine Human Rights Act regarding employment discrimination.
