26	State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law

10 FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this question out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
