HOUSE AMENDMENT "0" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1137, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part Y.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will reduce the General Fund cost of the bill by \$92,398 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$97,122 in fiscal year 1998-99.

SUMMARY

This amendment eliminates funding for 2 new Assistant District Attorney positions for York County.
