SENATE AMENDMENT " H " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1137, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment in Part S in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 257, line 48 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "System" the following: 'and the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System'

Further amend the amendment in Part S in section 3 in the 5th line (page 258, line 1 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "be" the following: 'proportionately'

Further amend the amendment in Part S in section 3 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 258, lines 2 and 3 in amendment) by striking out the following: "for the Maine Economic Improvement Strategy" and inserting in its place the following: 'and the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART XX

Sec. XX-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

for fiscal year 1997-98 and fiscal year 1998-99.



**SUMMARY**

14 This amendment deappropriates \$500,000 in fiscal year  
1997-98 and fiscal year 1998-99 for the Maine Economic  
16 Improvement Strategy and appropriates those same amounts to  
increase funding for the Maine Technical College System and the  
18 University of Maine System.

20 This amendment also removes the authority for the Maine  
Economic Improvement Strategy to receive up to \$2,000,000 from  
22 available balances at the close of fiscal year 1997-98 and  
substitutes increased funding for the University of Maine System  
24 and the Maine Technical College System.
