SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 833, L.D. 1138, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part Q the following:

PART R

Sec. R-1. Exemption from new renovation policy. Any school administrative unit placed on the protected list for a school construction project prior to January 1, 1997 is not subject to the renovation policy adopted by the State Board of Education at its January 15, 1997 meeting.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that any school administrative unit already placed on the protected list for a school construction project is not subject to the newly adopted renovation policy.
