## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA c. 24, as amended, is repealed.

	Sec. 2. Transition. Any rights, duties, obligations and
6	powers belonging to the Maine Turnpike Authority are transferred
	to and assumed by the Department of Transportation on January 1,
8	1999. The department shall submit a report, together with the
	necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing
10	Committee on Transportation no later than January 1, 1998, to
	accomplish this transition. This report must include the
12	mechanisms necessary for the department to assume all the rights,
	duties, obligations and powers of the Maine Turnpike Authority by
14	January 1, 1999.
<b>1</b> 6	Sec. 3. Effective date. Section 1 of this Act takes effect

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20	SUMMARY
22	This bill abolishes the Maine Turnpike Authority in 2 years
	and transfers duties and operation of the turnpike to the
24	Department of Transportation. The department is required to
	submit a plan by January 1, 1998 that will accomplish the
26	transfer by January 1, 1999.
