
HOUSE AMENDMENT "**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 782, L.D. 2109, Bill, "An Act to Reduce Motor Vehicle Fatalities and Injuries among Young Drivers"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of subparagraph (2) (page 2, lines 2 to 9 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(2) The person has completed a minimum of 35 hours of driving, including 5 hours of night driving, while accompanied by a parent, guardian or licensed driver at least 20 years of age. The parent or guardian, or a spouse or employer pursuant to section 1302, subsection 1, paragraphs B and C, must certify the person's driving time on a form prescribed by the Secretary of State.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that a spouse or employer is authorized to certify the required driving time of a person under the age of 18 who holds a driver's instruction permit.
