Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 9 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 9. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

17 This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the resolve
18 by \$852,610 in fiscal year 1998-99. It provides a General Fund
19 appropriation of \$50,000 to the Probation and Parole program
20 within the Department of Corrections to support the costs
21 associated with drug and alcohol testing. It also includes a
22 General Fund appropriation of \$1,050 for the Legislature for the
23 per diem and expenses of the legislative members of the study
24 panel.

26 **SUMMARY**

29 This amendment removes the General Fund appropriations that
30 were included in the supplemental budget bill, Public Law 1997,
31 chapter 643. It provides funding for alcohol and drug testing
32 and for the legislative costs associated with the study group.
