COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 809, L.D. 2187, "Resolve, Naming the New Bridge in Medway the Harold C. Beathem Bridge"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Name the New Bridge on Route 157 in Medway the Harold C. Beathem Bridge'

Further amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. New Route 157 bridge in Medway named. Resolved: That the new Route 157 bridge over the East Branch of the Penobscot River in Medway be known as the Harold C. Beathem Bridge in honor of the valued contributions Harold C. Beathem made as a community leader to the betterment of Medway.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor additional costs to provide signs or erect a plaque. These costs can be absorbed within the Department of Transportation's existing budgeted resources.'
