28	This bill expands eligibility for the Maine Seed Capital Tax Credit Program. This expansion will reduce individual income tax collections beginning in fiscal year 1998-99. If the tax credit usage increases by 10%, the resulting reductions of General Fund revenue will be approximately \$17,710 in fiscal year 1998-99, \$32,252 in fiscal year 1999-2000 and \$41,502 in fiscal year 2000-01. The corresponding decreases in dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing will be
