HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1565, L.D. 2198, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations Relating to the Review of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation's Office of the Commissioner, Office of Consumer Credit Regulation and Office of Licensing and Registration under the State Government Evaluation Act"

Amend the amendment on pages 2 and 3 by striking out all of the last indented paragraph beginning on page 2 (page 2, lines 44 to 50 and page 3, lines 1 to 4 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part C by striking out all of section 4.'

Further amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th indented paragraphs (page 3, lines 15 to 23 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part C by striking out all of section 9.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the minor savings that the Department of Human Services would have realized from transferring responsibility for the state plumbing code from the Department of Human Services to the Plumbers' Examining Board within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation. It also eliminates the board's future need for an additional

Plumbing Inspector position at an annual cost of approximately
\$34,000 to administer the state plumbing code.
