One member representing the general public who resides 32 in central Maine, appointed by the Governor; ' 34 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$13090-K.</u>" in subsection 1 by relettering the paragraphs to read 36 consecutively. 38 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$13090-K.</u>" in subsection 3 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 2, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "by January 40 lst of each year" 42 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$13090-K.</u>" in subsection 3 in paragraph C by inserting at the 44 end a new sentence to read: 'The first report must be provided 46 by February 1, 2000 and subsequent reports are due by February 1st of each year thereafter,' 48

#### APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

#### General Fund

The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$2,840 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the per diem and expenses of legislative members and public hearing costs of the Maine Economic Opportunity Advisory Committee. The annual costs of the committee beginning with fiscal year 1999-2000 and continuing through fiscal year 2006-07 are estimated to be \$3,340. The additional costs associated with providing staff assistance to the committee during any interim between sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Economic and Community Development, the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Transportation and the Department of Conservation will incur some

minor additional costs to participate as members of the committee. These costs can be absorbed within the respective departments' existing budgeted resources.'

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment provides for an additional public member of the Maine Economic Opportunity Advisory Committee from central Maine. In addition, the amendment changes the committee's first reporting date to February 1, 2000, with subsequent reports due annually by February 1st thereafter. It also adds an appropriation and a fiscal note to the bill.
