COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 52, L.D. 122, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Amend the Timing of Elections Following the Submission of a Petition for People's Veto"

Amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this constitutional resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 119th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, this resolution will allow the state and municipalities to avoid costs in the future as a result of not having to hold special elections for people's vetoes.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the resolution.
