COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 126, L.D. 157, Bill, "An Act to Allow Review of Examination-related Issues in Executive Session"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph G (page 1, lines 13 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'G. Discussion or approval of the content of examinations administered by a body or agency for licensing, permitting or employment purposes; consultation between a body or agency and any entity that provides examination services to that body or agency regarding the content of an examination; and review of examinations with the person examined.'

SUMMARY

This amendment narrows the exemptions to the provision governing executive sessions of State Government. It allows a body or agency of the State to deliberate in executive session only to discuss or approve the content of examinations, to consult with an examination provider with regard to the content of an examination and to review the results of an examination with the person examined.
