An Act to Repeal the Law That Requires the Display of a Registration Plate on the Front of a Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §452, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, $\S2$ and affected by Pt. B, $\S5$, is amended to read: 4 Position of registration plate. 6 1. A registration plate must be displayed horizontally. Only one set of Maine registration plates may be displayed on one vehicle. 8 Α registration plate must be attached to the front-and-the rear of 10 each vehicle, and may be attached to the front of each vehicle, except as follows. 12 Α. A trailer and semitrailer registration plate may be 14 attached only to the rear of that trailer or semitrailer. A motorcycle or motor-driven cycle registration plate 16 в. may not be attached to the front of that motorcycle or motor-driven cycle. 18 20 C. A manufacturer, dealer or transporter registration plate may be attached only to the rear of the vehicle. 22 D. A truck tractor registration plate may be attached only 24 to the front of that truck tractor. **SUMMARY** 26 28 law concerning the This bill amends the display of registration plates on motor vehicles by maintaining the requirement of the display of a rear plate, while making display 30 of a front plate optional. 32
