

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1201, sub-§3-A, as amended by PL 1997, c.**  
373, §106, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 **3-A. Sale of liquor to another retailer. A person licensed**  
7 **under this section, or an agent or employee of the person, may**  
8 **sell liquor to a retailer licensed to sell liquor for on-premises**  
9 **consumption and caterers licensed to sell liquor for consumption**  
10 **at the location sold.**

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows a retailer with a license to sell wine and  
16 malt liquor to be consumed off of the premises to sell wine and  
17 malt liquor to other entities with a license to sell liquor for  
18 on-premise consumption.
