2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2307-C is enacted to read:

6 **§2307-C. Information concerning school administrative unit's  
experience rating**

8 Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing  
10 confidentiality, a nonprofit hospital or medical service  
12 organization shall provide information concerning a school  
14 administrative unit's own experience and claims history as a  
16 member covered under a group policy or contract to that school  
18 administrative unit at that unit's own request and to the  
20 municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so

24 Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2803-B is enacted to read:

26 **§2803-B. Information concerning school administrative unit's  
experience rating**

28 Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing  
30 confidentiality, an insurer shall provide information concerning  
32 a school administrative unit's own experience and claims history  
34 as a member covered under a group policy or contract to that  
36 school administrative unit at that unit's own request and to the  
38 municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so  
40 requests.

42 Sec. 3. 24-A MRSA §4224-B is enacted to read:

**§4224-B. Information concerning school administrative unit's  
experience rating**

Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing  
confidentiality, a health maintenance organization shall provide  
information concerning a school administrative unit's own  
experience and claims history as a member covered under a group  
policy or contract to that school administrative unit at that  
unit's own request and to the municipality in which the unit is  
located if the municipality so requests.

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## SUMMARY

4           This bill requires that insurers, nonprofit hospital and  
6           medical service organizations and health maintenance  
8           organizations provide school administrative units with  
10           information concerning the unit's own experience rating and  
          claims history as a member covered under a group policy or  
          contract at the unit's request or at the request of the  
          municipality in which the unit is located.

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
