COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 429, L.D. 1266,  
"RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine  
to Promote Historic and Scenic Preservation"

Amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the  
summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The estimated cost of sending this constitutional amendment  
out to referendum will vary according to the total number of  
referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 119th  
Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The  
estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda  
are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an  
additional \$7,000.'
