
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1572, L.D. 2220, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Sections 61, 62, 63, 68, 69 and 73 of 10-149, Chapter 5: Bureau of Elder and Adult Services Policy Manual, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Human Services"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 8 in the 4th line (page 2, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Legislators,"

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 8 in the last line (page 2, line 44 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "consumers." the following: 'The department shall provide notice of all meetings to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services.'
