COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 864, L.D. 2262, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit the Sale of Items in Storage Owned by a 3rd Party"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1-A in the 7th line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "operator" the following: 'by the occupant'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1-A in the 8th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "storage" the following: 'or by a 3rd party at any time prior to the lien sale pursuant to section 1375, subsection 1'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 3 in the 4th line (page 3, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection 1" and inserting in its place the following: 'subsections 1 and 11'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that proof of ownership by a 3rd party must be provided to the operator by the occupant or the 3rd party. The amendment also adds a provision that would allow a 3rd party to redeem the 3rd party's property from a storage unit notwithstanding a section of law that vests the exclusive custody of all property in the occupant.
