HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1627, L.D. 2274, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Authority of Maine Game Wardens to Stop Motor Vehicles"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph D-3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "section 105" the following: 'only'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment adds the word "only" to the language of the committee amendment to clarify that a game warden may stop a motor vehicle in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 105 only if the warden has a reasonable and articulable suspicion that a violation of any law of this State is taking place or has taken place or to protect public safety.
