COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 877, L.D. 2292

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 2 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill, contingent on the approval by New Hampshire and Vermont of similar legislation, may result in additional future General Fund revenue from lottery sales. The amount of any future revenue and the timing can not be determined at this time.

16 The additional costs associated with seeking partnerships with other multi-state lotteries and submitting legislation can 18 be absorbed by the State Liquor and Lottery Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
