Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13011, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

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9. Targeted need certificate. The state board shall adopt rules that establish criteria under which a targeted need area certificate may be issued. This certificate may be issued only to a person holding a bachelor's degree and teaching in a teacher shortage area. The teacher shortage area is determined by the commissioner. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

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SUMMARY

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This bill creates a new certificate authorizing a person to teach in an area determined to be a "teacher shortage area," which the Department of Education would issue only when certain criteria are met and special circumstances exist.
