Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

## **FISCAL NOTE**

12 Redesigning the fine schedule for violations by vehicles registered for 100,000 pounds will not result in any net change 14 in the amount of fine revenue collected.

16 The Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State will incur some minor additional costs to
18 administer certain changes in truck weight requirements and to adopt certain rules pertaining to truck weight permit fees.
20 These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor 24 weight additional costs to administer certain truck the requirements. These costs can be absorbed within department's existing budgeted resources. 26

28 The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with 30 the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease 32 General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
