SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 9, "JOINT ORDER to Enact the Joint Rules"

Amend the order by striking out all of Joint Rule 203-A.

Further amend the order by striking out all of Joint Rule 205 and inserting in its place the following:


'Rule 205. Filing after Cloture.

Any request for a bill or resolve submitted to the Revisor of Statutes by a Legislator or a department, agency or commission after the appropriate cloture date must be transmitted to the Legislative Council. The council shall ascertain from the sponsor the facts supporting the request notwithstanding cloture. If a majority of the council approves, the legislation is eligible for introduction as other legislation that is in compliance with Rule 202 or 203.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the provisions governing cloture for the Governor.
