SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 9, "JOINT ORDER to Enact the Joint Rules"

Amend the order by striking out all of Joint Rule 203-A and inserting in its place the following:

**'Rule 203-A. Cloture for Governor's Bills and Resolves.**

A Legislator may not submit a bill or resolve on behalf of the Governor after 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the first Monday in January, except that if the convening of a first regular session coincides with the beginning of a newly elected Governor's first term, a Legislator may not submit a bill or resolve on behalf of the Governor after 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the first Monday in February.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that a Legislator may not submit a bill or resolve on behalf of the Governor after 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the first Monday in January, except that if the convening of a first regular session coincides with the beginning of a newly elected Governor's first term, a Legislator may not submit a bill or resolve on behalf of the Governor after 4:00 p.m. on the Friday following the first Monday in February.
