
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 958, "JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO FULFILL THE ORIGINAL INTENT TO FUND 40% OF THE COSTS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION MANDATES TO THE STATES UNDER THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT"

Amend the resolution in the 2nd paragraph from the end in the 2nd line by inserting after the following: "Congress of the United States" the following: 'either'

Further amend the resolution in the 2nd paragraph from the end in the last line by inserting after the following: "disabilities" the following: 'or amend the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to allow the states more flexibility in implementing its mandates'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the joint resolution to respectfully urge and request that the President of the United States and the Congress of the United States either provide 40% of the national average per pupil expenditure to assist states and local education agencies with the excess costs of educating children with disabilities or amend the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to allow the states more flexibility in implementing its mandates.
