20 Establish the Committee on Workforce Investment"


22 Amend the Joint Study Order by striking out all of section 2
24 and inserting in its place the following:

26 **'2. Committee membership.** The committee consists of 12
28 members appointed as follows. The President of the Senate shall
30 appoint 5 Senators, one from each of the following joint standing
committees: Appropriations and Financial Affairs, Education and
Cultural Affairs, Health and Human Services, Business and
Economic Development and Labor. The Speaker of the House shall
appoint 7 members of the House, one from each of the following
joint standing committees: Appropriations and Financial Affairs,
Education and Cultural Affairs, Health and Human Services, and
Business and Economic Development and 3 members from Labor.'

32 Further amend the Joint Study Order in section 5 in the 2nd
34 line by striking out the following: "States" and inserting in
its place the following: 'State'
