Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§6751." in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "season for that sport" and inserting in its place the following: 'year'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

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The requirement that local school units establish certain guidelines and may be required to provide services that may not be currently provided during the school year represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs are indeterminate at this time. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a mandate preamble is amended to the bill and 2/3 of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, local school units may not be required to implement these changes.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment strikes the part in the bill that would allow student athletes and coaches to participate in sports-related activities at any time throughout the calendar year and instead requires all school administrative units to allow student athletes and coaches to participate in sports-related activities at any time throughout the school year. It also adds a mandate preamble and a fiscal note.

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
