2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1819**, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 678, §13, is
amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 A resident of the town in which a state-owned park is
8 located is not required to pay a fee for admission to that
state-owned park.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill eliminates the fee for the use of a state-owned
14 park by a resident of the town in which the state-owned park is
located.
