12	A cause of action does not lie in law or equity to require
	an employer to retain an employee or employees hired to replace
14	workers who participated in a labor dispute.

	The bill invalidates a contract that attempts to prevent an
20	employer from rehiring employees displaced during a labor
	dispute and from removing workers who were hired to replace
22	striking employees. It specifies that no cause of action lies in
	state courts to require an employer to retain an employee or
24	employees hired to replace workers who participate in a labor

dispute.

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
