2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶J** is enacted to read:

6 J. The Saturday preceding the residents-only Saturday, as  
8 designated in paragraph E, subparagraph (3), must be an open  
day for junior hunters only. The adult accompanying a  
junior hunter is not allowed to hunt or carry a firearm.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides an extra day of hunting for junior  
14 license holders by designating the Saturday preceding the  
16 residents-only Saturday as a day for junior hunters only.
