COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 48, L.D. 57, Bill, "An Act to Require That Certain Employees Be Paid on a Weekly Basis"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 8. Regulation of employment poster. The Department of Labor shall include notice of the requirements of this Act in its next reprinting of the regulation of employment poster.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds language directing the Department of Labor to include notice of the weekly pay requirements in its next reprinting of the regulation of employment poster, to avoid additional costs of immediately reprinting and mailing the poster. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
