COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 95, L.D. 99, "Resolve, to Name Route 302 the 10th Mountain Division Highway"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Designate Route 302 the 10th Mountain Division Highway. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall designate the part of Route 302 that starts in the City of Portland and continues through the Town of Fryeburg the "10th Mountain Division Highway." This designation may not change or otherwise affect any other names that municipalities may have adopted for this part of Route 302.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor additional costs to rename a section of Route 302. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve and requires the Department of Transportation to designate the part of Route 302 that starts in the City of Portland and continues through the Town of Fryeburg the "10th Mountain Division Highway." This
