8	The increase in salaries will increase the operating costs of Kennebec County. The estimated annual cost is approximately		
10	\$4,800. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the		
12	constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.
