Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:


FISCAL NOTE

The Secretary of State will incur some minor additional costs to distribute voting rights posters to each municipality. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes and replaces the fiscal note on the committee amendment. The bill as amended does not represent a state mandate under the Constitution of Maine.
