Amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection 6 in the last line (page 2, line 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection 7 in the last line (page 2, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "be it further"

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the 2nd subsection 7 the following:


'8. Compare the costs, revenue and social implications of a proposed Maine-based casino with the proposal to expand gaming at commercial harness racing tracks as proposed in the referendum language certified by the Secretary of State on November 2, 2001; and be it further'
