SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1700, L.D. 2200, "Resolve, to Study the Impact of a Maine-based Casino on the Economy, Transportation Infrastructure, State Revenues and the Job Market"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "one member from" and inserting in its place the following: 'with preference given to members serving on'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "one from"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 35 to 44 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, with preference given to members who are tribal representatives and who serve on the following committees: the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters; the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over gaming matters; the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters; and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human services matters.'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 2nd subsection 5 (page 2, lines 38 to 39 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection

SENATE AMENDMENT ^C to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1700,

6 in the first line (page 2, line 41 in amendment) by striking
out the following: "6." and inserting in its place the following:
'5.'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection
7 in the first line (page 2, line 44 in amendment) by striking
out the following: "7." and inserting in its place the following:
'6.'

Further amend the amendment on page 3 by inserting before
the first indented paragraph the following:

'Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 5 the
following:

'Sec. 6. Meetings. Resolved: That the task force may hold up
to 4 meetings. One meeting may be a public hearing held in the
Augusta area.'

Further amend the amendment on page 3 in section 8 in the
5th to 7th lines (page 3, lines 8 to 10 in amendment) by striking
out the following: "January 2, 2003. The joint standing
committees are authorized to introduce legislation" and inserting
in its place the following: 'November 6, 2002. Each joint
standing committee is authorized to introduce a bill'

Further amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of
the 3rd indented paragraph (page 3, lines 13 and 14 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of
section 11 (page 3, lines 16 to 32 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 11
the following:

'Further amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any
nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
consecutively.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriation for
the Task Force to Study the Impact of a Maine-based Casino. The
revised General Fund cost of the task force is estimated to be
\$6,820 in fiscal year 2002-03. This cost can be absorbed within
the Legislature's existing budgeted resources utilizing available
balance forward from fiscal year 2001-02.

the Legislative Council on March 26, 2002.


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The amendment changes Legislator membership provisions;
