HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1746, L.D. 2220, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment in Part FF by inserting at the end the following new section:

Sec. FF-2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF 0308

General Purpose Aid to Local Schools

Initiative: Provides funds to restore \$8,000,000 of the \$10,000,000 curtailment in fiscal year 2002-03. Of this \$8,000,000 appropriation, \$680,096 will be used to restore the 1.37% reduction to the State's share of the adjustments and miscellaneous costs component and \$7,319,904 will be used to restore the foundation component including the minimum subsidy.

General Fund	2002-03
All Other	\$8,000,000'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$8,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.


