Amend the amendment by inserting after Part RR the following:

PART SS

Sec. SS-1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Appropriates funds to partially offset a reduction contained in the statewide curtailment deappropriation in Part A, section 1 of this Act.

Initiative: Deappropriates funds in the Regional Operations program.

17 provision of law, the State Budget Officer shall calculate and
18 distribute the unallocated amount in section 1 of this Part that
19 applies against the Personal Services or All Other line category
20 within the Regional Operations program by financial order upon
21 the recommendation of the Commissioner of Behavioral and
22 Developmental Services and the approval of the Governor. These
23 transfers are considered adjustments to appropriations in fiscal
24 year 2002-03.'

32 This amendment has no net fiscal impact.


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36 **SUMMARY**

38 This amendment transfers \$300,000 in fiscal year 2002-03
39 from the General Fund Regional Operations program to the General
40 Fund Mental Health Services - Community Medicaid program within
41 the Department of Behavioral and Developmental Services to
42 partially offset a curtailment reduction contained in Part A,
43 section 1 of Committee Amendment "A" to House Paper 1746,
44 Legislative Document 2220. It also authorizes the State Budget
Officer to distribute the unallocated reduction among the line
categories of the Regional Operations program by financial order
