SENATE AMENDMENT '6' to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1746, L.D. 2220, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part RR the following:

PART SS

Sec. SS-1. Resolve 2001, c. 57, §2 is amended to read:

Sec. 2. Interstate exit numbering system. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall work with the Federal Highway Administration, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials and the Maine Turnpike Authority to change Maine's interstate exit numbering system for exits occurring south of Augusta exits only to one in which mile markers determine exit numbers.

Sec. SS-2. Retroactivity. This Part applies retroactively to September 21, 2001.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on the General Fund budget for fiscal year 2002-03.


