HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 756, "Joint Study Order to Study Retention of, Recruitment of and Access to Unemployment Compensation for School Bus Drivers"

Amend the order in subsection 2 in the first line by striking out the following: "8" and inserting in its place the following: '10'

Further amend the order in subsection 2 in paragraph E in the last line by striking out all the following: "and"

Further amend the order in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph E the following:

'F. One member who represents owners of companies that provide school bus service to school administrative units, appointed by the President of the Senate;

G. One member who is the superintendent of a school administrative unit, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and'

Further amend the order in subsection 2 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

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
**SUMMARY**

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This amendment adds 2 members to the Commission to Study  
Issues Concerning School Bus Drivers: one who represents owners  
6 of companies that provide school bus service to school  
administrative units and one who is a superintendent of a school  
8 administrative unit.
