D. Are proportionally equivalent to the total conservation expenditures of other transmission and distribution utilities, based on total transmission and distribution revenues, unless the commission finds that a different amount is justified; however, any increase in an assessment en-a-transmission and distribution utility by the commission must be based on factors other than the achievement of proportional equivalency.
