of Education shall develop rules regarding the payment and

8 **Sec. 2. Rules. Resolved:** That rules adopted pursuant to this
resolve are major substantive rules as defined in the Maine
10 Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

14 This resolve requires the Department of Education to adopt
major substantive rules for the apportionment of money for school
16 transportation costs to pay for school crossing guards.
